SO 1.17 Sealing of Filed Trial or Hearing Transcripts

When the court reporter files a trial or hearing transcript in the record, the Clerk of Court has the

authority to seal that transcript prior to redaction if the transcript contains personally identifiable

information, including the names of minor children, social security numbers, taxpayer-identification

numbers, or birthdates. This order does not negate the duty of attorneys of record to comply with

Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 5.2 and Federal Rule of Criminal Procedure 49.1 and/or to review the

transcript to request redaction when appropriate.
