
**STANDING ORDER NO. 1.98**

Regarding implementation of the REAL ID Act of 2005, any Federal implementation policy or guideline notwithstanding, the authority to order otherwise being reserved to this Court, it is

ORDERED that a valid Louisiana Driver's License, or official Louisiana Identification Card, even if not in compliance with the REAL ID Act, shall remain an acceptable form of identification for admission to any United States District Courthouse or Bankruptcy Courthouse in the Western District of Louisiana. However, nothing in this order shall prevent any court officer from refusing to admit any person for any other reason. It is further

ORDERED that the procedure allowed here shall remain in effect unless revoked or vacated by the Court.
